moun·tain—**MOWN-tuhn** *noun* a tall peak of land, much higher than a hill

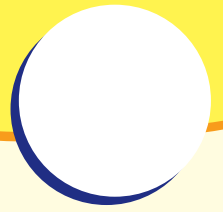
nat·u·ral—**NATCH-er-uhl** 1. *adjective* the way nature made it, not changed by humans 2. *adjective* not fake

shade—**shad** *noun* a place where the sun is blocked by something, like under a tree

soil—**soyl** 1. *noun* dirt that is used for growing plants 2. *verb* to make something dirty

val·ley—**VAL-ee** *noun* a low spot between hills or mountains

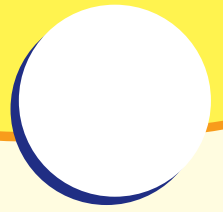

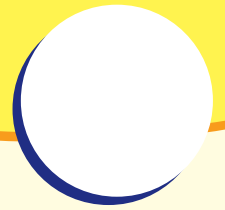
